Abbreviated Board Meeting Minutes

October 4, 2005

After our regular membership meeting, President, Bill Moller, called this specially-called board meeting to order at Chevy's, with the following officers present: Bill Moller, Angie Imura, Kathy Silver, Bob Burke, Denise Guaraglia, Rel Kempf, Mary Anne Nielsen, and Brenda Cash, and member Mark Wilson, with board member Allan Brum standing by. President Bill's purpose for the meeting was to discuss our Pre-Race Ski Season Kickoff Party and its budget. After discussion, a motion was made, seconded and passed: **"A Pre-Ski Season Race Kickoff Party will be held at Sonia's Rec Room with a \$400 budget."** After further discussion, it was decided members would be charged \$5 for the party, non-members will be charged \$20. Non-members who pay the \$20 party fee who join that night or within the month will be given \$15 credit toward their dues. The next Board meeting will be as regularly scheduled on October 18th. The meeting then ended.

BAC News

The **BAC 2005-2006 Discount Lift Ticket Purchase Program** is underway, and we need your help to ensure success! This program extends to 10,000+ members one of BAC's most meaningful benefits: deep discounts on lift tickets. Who *doesn't* want to save money on the high cost of the sport we love?! In addition to passing on great savings to our members, this program is BAC's only fundraiser. We add a surcharge of \$1.00 to every new lift ticket we sell. This year, all returned tickets that are reordered for this ski season will have a \$2.00 surcharge. This is a small amount paid by each buyer, but it adds up to significant income for the BAC. The council uses these funds, along with membership dues to provide important benefits like publishing the monthly newsletter, making copies of flyers and other important information you take back to your clubs, and ensuring Bay Area ski clubs are well represented at the Far West Ski Association convention in June.

You will save (approx. 15%) when you buy through the BAC. Most lift tickets are good any day all season long. Alpine is the exception with some holiday black-out dates which are listed on the order form. The tickets can be returned for credit towards next year's program. Some resorts will let you use them for mountain biking or golf (for example, Northstar). These early-season discounts are generally more cost effective than the corporate ticket.

Because I will have to collect and tally our club's tickets in order to submit them at the BAC meeting in November, I must have the orders by November 1st. I will collect them at the club meetings or you may mail them to me. (I'll post an address.) Look for the "Discount Lift Ticket Order Form" in the October issue of *Snowfooling*. Lift tickets orders will be available around Thanksgiving. I will also distribute orders at the December Inskiers events and functions.

When reviewing the order form, note that ticket prices for **Alpine Meadows & Dodge Ridge** are estimated to avoid delay in releasing ordering forms & information. Refunds will be given when order is submitted if the final resorts price is less than the BAC price.

Also note that **Sugar Bowl** dropped prices and eliminated the youth ticket. Deduct \$6 for each repurchased ticket using 04-05 credits. This applies to adult & youth credits due.
